to flying condition, with several more projects waiting their turn. As well as up to 13 Spitfires on site there is a 1940 Hawker Hurricane and Battle of Britain veteran Messerschmitt 109 on view. The 2:00pm guided tour will include

getting up-close to many of the Spitfires based at the Heritage Hangar, including the restoration projects. The opportunity to sit in a Spitfire cockpit is available for an additional charge of £30 per person (as below).
